




### San Diego Region: Impact of the Blue Economy

Recent report highlights San Diego as having one of the greatest concentrations of enterprise devoted to maritime science and technology in the world. Key findings include the following:

- In 2020, San Diego had **4,320 maritime, water, and BlueTech business** establishments
- From 2012 to 2020 (following numbers high, considering 2020 was a COVID year)
  - 169% increase in employment
  - 18% percent increase in revenues
- This industry:
  - Generated \$16.2 billion
  - When applying economic multiplier (see following page) San Diego's Blue Economy generated \$36.6 billion in economic impact
  - Employed more than 114,000 people (9% of its total employment)
  - In 2020, San Diego's <u>BlueTech-only</u> businesses employed about 24,000 people

THE SAN DIEGO MARITIME, WATER, AND BLUETECH ECONOMY IN 2020



#### **General Organizational Information**


- Founded in 2007, TMA is one of most important, and well-connected, maritime trade organizations in the US.

#### **Maritime Defense and Security**

San Diego is home to the 2nd largest US Navy port in the US. As such, there is a significant number of companies located in San Diego w/technologies in maritime defense and security.

In addition, Western nations around the world are placing heavy focus (and funding) on new defense/security technologies. With this in mind, TMA has recently launch a *strategic initiative* for the maritime defense/security sector, designed to **open significant opportunities for TMA member companies**, specifically those offering the following technologies:

- Robotics
- Sensors
- Autonomous vehicles
- Data/Al



#### **Maritime Decarbonization**

TMA has a strong relationship with the Port of San Diego (which is known as "The Port of Firsts").

Green Shipping Corridor MOU among ports of Singapore, LA and LB open West Coast US is key.

TMA recently signed an agreement with the **European Space Agency** to collaborate on international maritime decarbonization initiatives.
