





- **Grants** – Pauses, freezes, modifications & cancellations; backlog of 3,200 DOT grants alone
- **Executive Orders & Actions** – More than 200; roughly 40% challenged in court




2025 Balance of Power

Timeline for WRDA 2026

- **Spring/Summer 2025** – Committees hold hearings
- **Late Summer/Early Fall 2025** – Committees solicit Member requests
- **Fall 2025/Winter 2026** – Committees draft legislation
- **First quarter 2026** – Committees markup respective bills
- **Prior to August 2026** – Floor passage in House and Senate
- **August/Fall 2026** – Conference negotiations
- **December 2026** – Final WRDA bill passes


Timeline for Funding Actions

- **FY25 USACE Work Plan** – Expected this week
- **FY26 Skinny Budget Proposal** – Released 5/2/25
- **FY26 Full Budget Proposal** – Expected the week of 5/19/25
- **FY26 Programmatic and Project Funding Requests** – Programmatic deadlines have passed, project funding deadline 5/23/25
- **FY26 Budget Hearings** – Ongoing, USACE TBD
- **FY26 Appropriations bills** – Drafted prior to August recess
- **FY26 Appropriations bills finalized** – TBD
