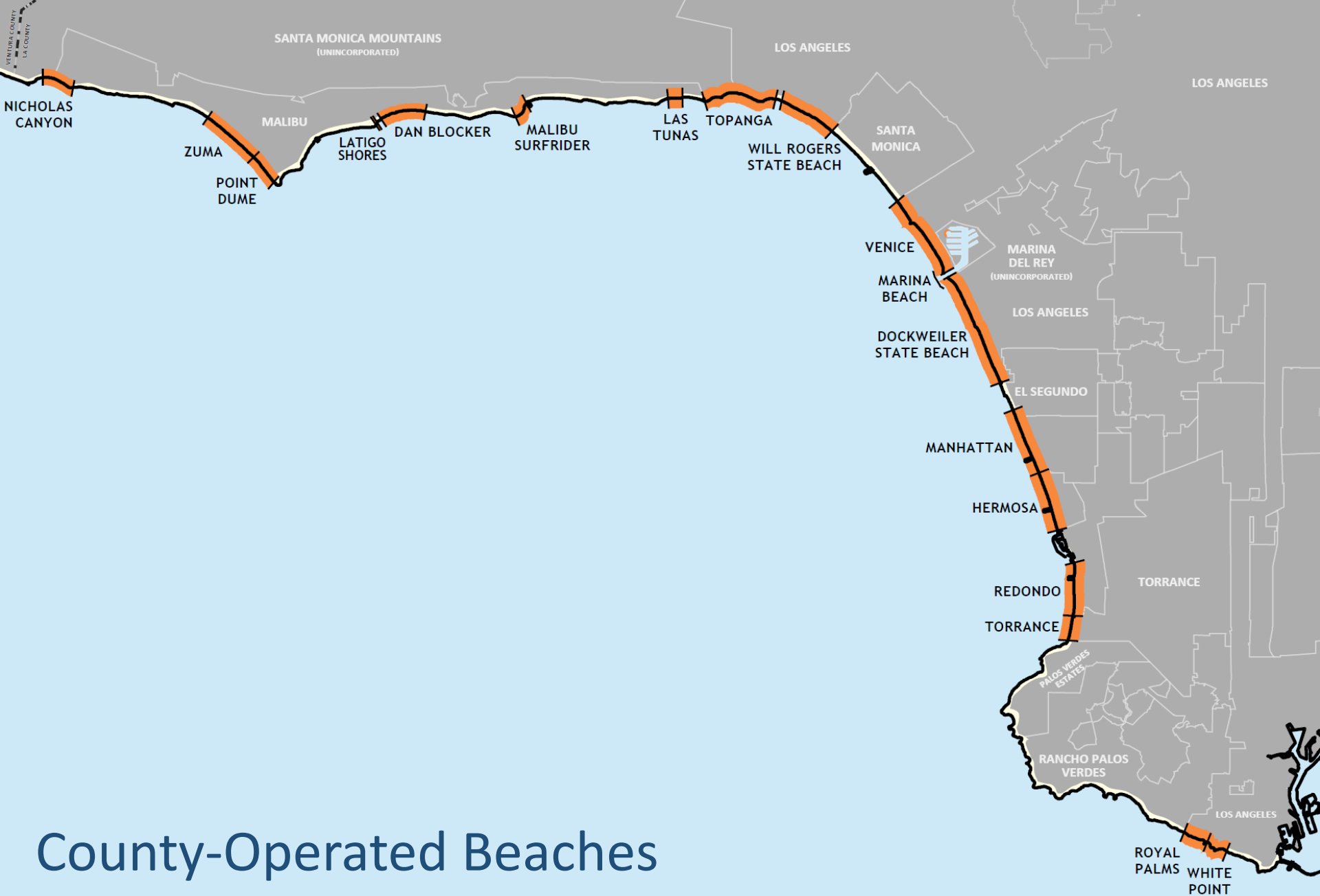

Marina del Rey Copper TMDL Re-Opener

- LA Regional Board Adoption: June 27, 2024
- State Water Board Public Review: Comments due Oct. 6, 2025

Item	2014 TMDL	2024 TMDL Re-Opener
Copper Numeric Target	3.1 ug/L	4.3 ug/L
Copper Load Allocation	85% reduction (repainting 85% of boats with non-copper paint)	54% reduction (repainting 54% of boats with non-biocide paint)
Compliance Deadline	3/22/2024	3/22/2026*

*2-year extension to allow Regional Board to develop a regulatory mechanism (i.e. permit, or clean-up and abatement order) to enforce the TMDL target.

Coastal Resilience Initiatives



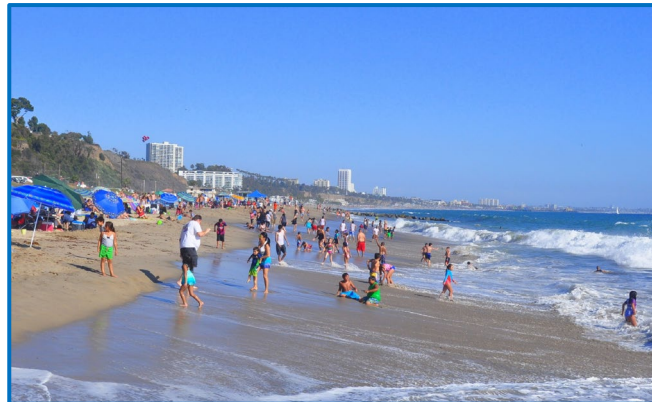
Living Shoreline Demonstration Projects

-Projects at Zuma, Dockweiler, and Redondo Beach consisting of dune restoration at all three sites and beach nourishment at Zuma and Redondo.



Sand Compatibility and Opportunistic Use Program (SCOUP)

-Beneficial use of opportunistically available sand for small beach nourishment projects
-Estimated completion mid-2026



LA County Regional Coastal Strategic Adaptation Plan (RCSAP)

-Multi-jurisdiction, all level stakeholder effort to prepare a sand management plan for LA County coastline
-Estimated completion in 2027
